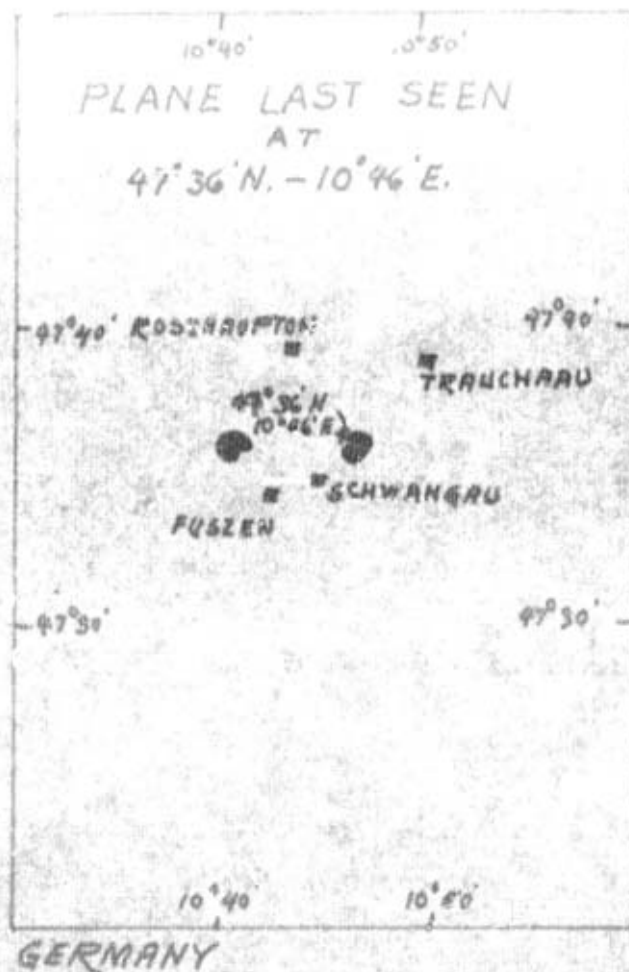

WITNESS STATEMENT

I was flying #23 position in Charlie Box. I saw a burst of flak burst under the right wing of Y/W, which was flying No. 13 in our box. Number 4 engine was feathered and number 2 engine started to smoke. The plane left the formation and I last saw it still going down to the left of the formation. The plane appeared to be under control when last seen.
