9. Twenty seven (27) a/c were over their respective targets and bombed by individual boxes with 500 pound MDX bombs (.1 nose and .025 tail) as follows:

a. Seven (7) a/c of Able Box were over Gun Position R-621013 at 1215B hours. Five (5) a/c dropped twelve and one half (12 1/2) tons of bombs from 16,500 feet: one a/c returned two and one half (2 1/2) tons of bombs to base, because of rack malfunction; one a/c jettisoned two and one half (2 1/2) tons of bombs at 430091E-029301E at a time when he was losing altitude and unable to keep position in formation due to

Clear at base at take-off and generally clear to Italian coast with visibility 20 miles. Clear, visibility 25 miles over Sicily to Corsica. Some cumulus, some starting to build. Clear from Corsica to target.

visibility 25 miles at base and any clouds.

On return, 1/10 cumulus over Corsica, base 8,000, top 11,000 feet.

Over Sicily, 2/10 cumulus built up to 13,000 feet, over Corsica.

Base on return, visibility 25 miles.

7. Four four (4) to thirty (30) P-51's were observed by the four bases from 1300 hours to 1350 hours between 42°11' - 42°14' and 12°16' - 12°18'.

8. Twenty seven (27) a/c landed at this base from 1600 hours to 1715 hours without incident.

9. The route was flown as briefed. Track chart showing route as flown and as briefed is enclosed.

10. None of the a/c of this group received flak damage.
